Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Sarah. A. Neeley her heirs and assigns forever. And I hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Sarah A. Neeley her heirs & assigns against me and my heirs and against all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal This 21st day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand-eight-hundred & sixty-seven.
