the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said S. F. Freeman all that piece parcel or tract of land
situate and lying in Richland County S. C. and contain-
ing sixty acres. Bound North
by land of Hester M. Stark
East by Hester M. Stark and Robt A. Davis, on the South by
John T. Duncan and West by lands of Margaret Campbell being
the same tract of land conveyed to me by Hester M. Stark

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances [sic]
to the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said S. F. Freeman and his
heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors, and administgrators, to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said S. F. Freeman and his heirs and assigns against me
and my heirs or any other persons lawfully claiming or to claim, the same or any part thereof.

Witness my hand and seal this 15th day of December in the year of our Lord
one thousand nine hundred and six and in the one hundred and 30th year of the sovereignty and independence of the
United States of America.
