

**James C Pollard**, P.O. Cambridge. Son of Abner (soldier of War of 1812) and Martha Pollard was born in Frankfort, Kentucky, June 15, 1820. After going to school for a while, he was apprenticed to a shoemaker, until his 18th year. In 1838 his family came to Callaway Co, Missouri, where he came also, and concluded to learn the Blacksmith trade. He then moved to Boone Co and then to Monroe Co, where he remained 5 years, and engaged to learn the boot and shoe business. He then moved to Randolph co and stayed there 16 years. From Randolph co, he came to Saline Co, where he engaged in farming, and then went to Johnson Co but did not like Johnson and returned to Saline. In September, 1840 he married Miss Elizabeth Haley who bore him one daughter, Lizzie H. His wife died, and he married on the 26th of Dec 1875, to Miss Sarah Bella Nickell. Though he had tried three occupations, blacksmith, shoemaker and farming, Mr. Pollard is doing well financially.
